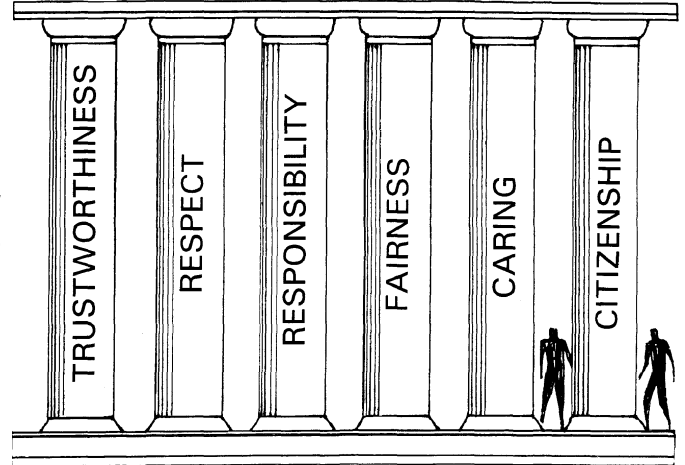
## Understanding Values and Virtues

The **Ethical Process** in finding solutions to any problem.

**Think**

**Weigh** all the parts which make up the problem. Separating the symptoms from the causes.

**Investigate** the perception of the ethical dilemma. Is it based on selfishness, self-interest, self-protection or self-righteousness? (The four natural enemies to ethics.)

**Now**, is right or wrong involved? How do we determine which is involved?

**Know** your ethical vocabulary (six pillars). Review and reflect on their supporting words.

**Look** for the higher ethic or standard.

**Evaluate** the outcome. Is it truly a good character decision?

**What did Ruth do to help her mother-in-law?**

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**What Character Words did Ruth demonstrate by helping her mother-in-law?**

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**How do we know Naomi had good character?**

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**Answer the questions and give the Character Word that applies to each answer.**

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What did he do to help Ruth?

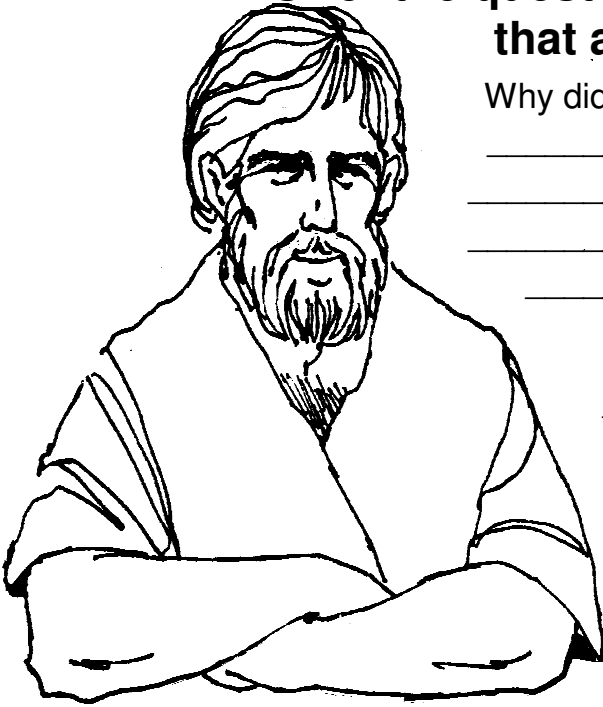
